

Earthquake Kit List

Small Kit (“Go-bag”) (one “go-bag” for each family member’s car):

- Copy of family earthquake plan with phone numbers
- List of Family Info – Work addresses, social security numbers, allergies to any drug (especially antibiotics) or food
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Hand Crank Emergency Radio (w/ cell phone charger)
- First Aid kit
- Personal documents (copies of health insurance, life insurance, homeowners/rental insurance, financial records, identification cards & credit cards, household inventory, up-to-date child vaccination records)
- Up-to-date Pet medical records (shelters may not take pets without this)
- Photos of family members and pets (for re-identification purposes)
- Cash (small denominations, include quarters)
- Sharpie, notepad and tape
- Dust Masks
- Swiss Army Knife or Leatherman Tool
- Local Map
- Some water and food
- Whistle
- Toiletries (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, tampons)
- Sunblock
- Spray Mister (for misting/cooling in the desert heat)

Large Kit (to be kept in a portable container next to an exit)

- 3-day supply of nonperishable, canned or dehydrated food (date all food items)
- Extra Keys to your house and vehicles
- Blanket (one per person)
- Extra set of clothing (one per person)
- Manual can opener
- Water purification tablets
- Waterproof Matches
- Large contractor trash bags or plastic sheeting (Can be used for shelter, storage, ponchos)
- Small heavy duty trash bags (for waste disposal)
- Nylon Rope
- Lightweight stove
- Sterno or other brand of heating fuel
- Work gloves
- Toilet paper
- Eating utensils, paper plates, plastic cups
- Crowbar/prybar
- Duct tape
- Bungee cords
- Hand sanitizer
- Fluorescent Lantern
- Pets: 3-day supply of canned pet food, extra water, pet carrier
- Child: Diapers and wipes

Water: Minimum of 2 gallons per person per day for drinking. An additional half gallon of water for cooking and hygiene.
